Buon Natale Report : Final report has been submitted to the Office of Economic and Workforce Development for reimbursement.

**Dignity Health:** Stephanie Dang of Dignity Health made a presentation about the urgent care location in North Beach. The facility has four exam rooms, x-rays on site, and labs. They accept in-network, Medicare, and Medi-cal. Open seven days a week: M-F 8a.m. to 8p.m. and S/S 9a.m. to 5p.m.

Patients can check on line to determine wait times to be seen.

**Adopt A Street:** Danny reported that we can submit an application to the City for a certain area and receive the supplies from the City. We are considering Grant Avenue because it is consistently dirty; however, the group decided to send out a survey to get feedback from the neighbors. Danny will prepare the survey and send to the Board as well.

**Farmers' Market:** The MIA has bowed out of the Market. Danny has contacted Pacific Coast Farmers Market group and they want to work with us on bringing the market to North Beach. The garage at Filbert and Columbus would offer a discounted rate of \$15.00. The areas under consideration are Powell between Greenwich and Filbert and Greenwich between Columbus and Powell. The market would begin Spring 2018 as we need to work on the outreach and ISCOT which takes time.

88 Broadway is moving forward. The Board supported a favorable letter of support. The project went to the Historical Preservation Board and was well received with a few minor changes. The project is moving to the CEQA, potential construction to start in 2019. Pier 31 ½ and Pier 33 under development for covered structures for Alcatraz centers. Embarcadero at Washington Streets is scheduled to get sewer repairs starting this summer. SPUC,DPW 8a.m. to 3p.m. Southbound closure. Trish suggested community meetings to inform the public as the City is paralyzed from all the street closures and construction. Pier 29 will be updated at the next meeting.

**Big Belly:** Trish will contact Kevin to schedule the walk thru the neighborhood soon. We are looking for volunteers to do the walk thru with Kevin. Once the walk thru is complete, then a meeting with Recology regarding the commercial corridor.

There will be no meeting scheduled for December and instead, an invitation to Buon Natale will be sent out.
